What We Do



We facilitated community vital service accessibility assessments in Juneau, Kenai, and Metlakatla and created reports with dashboard and resource lists.



- Launched AK Family Resource Center Network
- Signed on two new member FRCs that have served hundreds of families in FY24. Two new member FRCs beginning Oct '24.
- Trained FRC employees on evidence-based family assessment tool
- Distributed \$40k in start up funding for FRCs



We created the Family Assistance Management System for family serving agencies. This is a multi-user online case management database. We can now collect statewide data regarding what families are seeking and track referrals and services offered. Evidence-based tools are embedded in the system.

We maintained the Alaska Evidence-Based, Promising Practice, and Culturally-tailored Clearinghouse

- Developed the statewide Unlicensed Relative Caregiver Stipend & Respite program. These caregivers are taking care of relative's children without being licensed foster parents.
- This program provides financial support, respite, and service referrals, this reduces child trauma by keeping kids with family and decreases the need for stranger foster care.
- Established program evaluation and research team
- Application on our website. First payments went out August 1, 2024.
- \$164,000 will be distributed by October 2024.



- Designed a statewide resource and system navigation app – launches October 2024
- Integrates 211
- Has program eligibility calculators
- Available in most languages

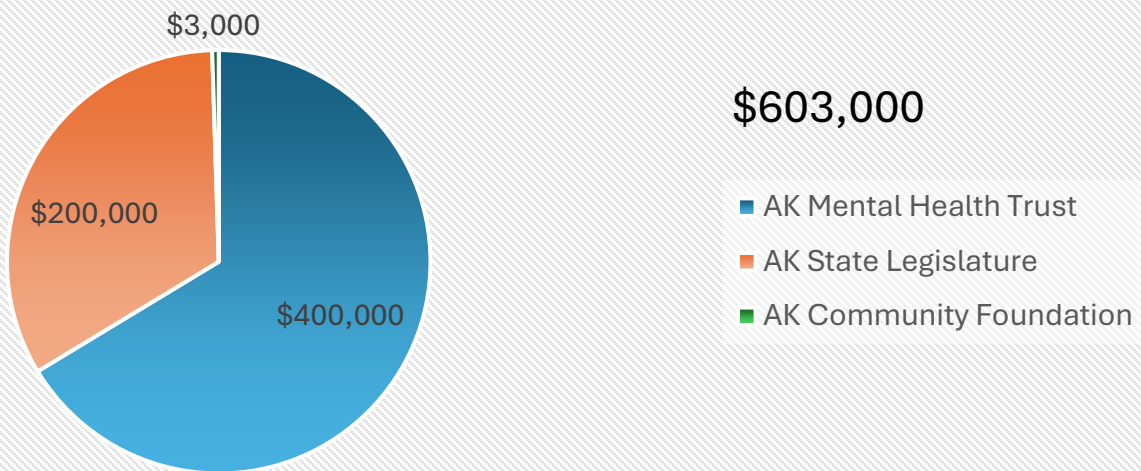
How We Do It
