The 907 Navigation App is a free tool that helps Alaskans find and navigate local resources, social services, and benefit systems. It offers up-to-date information, step-by-step guides, and additional tools to assist individuals and families.

How is the 907 Navigation App different from Alaska 211?

The 907 Navigation App works alongside Alaska 211 by integrating its resource listings directly in the app. However, the app also offers:

- Step-by-Step Guidance: Simplifies complex systems like healthcare and housing with helpful videos.
- Resource Raven Al Chatbot: Available 24/7 to answer questions and offer guidance.
- Benefit Eligibility Calculators: Helps users check their eligibility for various programs.
- Multilingual Support
- · Accessibility Features: Adapts to your device's screen readers and text-to-speech settings.

Is the 907 Navigation App free to use?

Yes, the app is completely free and funded by the State of Alaska and the Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority.

How do I download the 907 Navigation App?

You can download it from the Apple App Store (iOS) or Google Play Store (Android) by searching "907 Navigation."

Do I need an account to use the app?

No, you can access all features without creating an account or logging in.

What types of resources are available in the app?

Resources include housing, healthcare, financial assistance, food security, mental health, childcare, and more.

How does the app help with benefit applications or systems navigation?

The app provides step-by-step guides and videos to help you understand and apply for programs. You can take pictures of documents and email them using your phone's mail app.

How is the app updated?

The app is updated in real time through an administration panel. Users can recommend resources, which are verified and added within 2-3 business days.

Does the app collect personal data?

No personal information is collected. The app tracks general usage, such as downloads and popular resources, to improve functionality while maintaining privacy.

Can I contribute content to the app?

Yes! You can suggest resources through the app or the AIA website. After verification, they will be added to the app.

Does a resource need a website to be listed?

Yes, all resources must have a publicly available online link, such as a website, Google Maps link, or social media page to provide accurate and up-to-date information.
